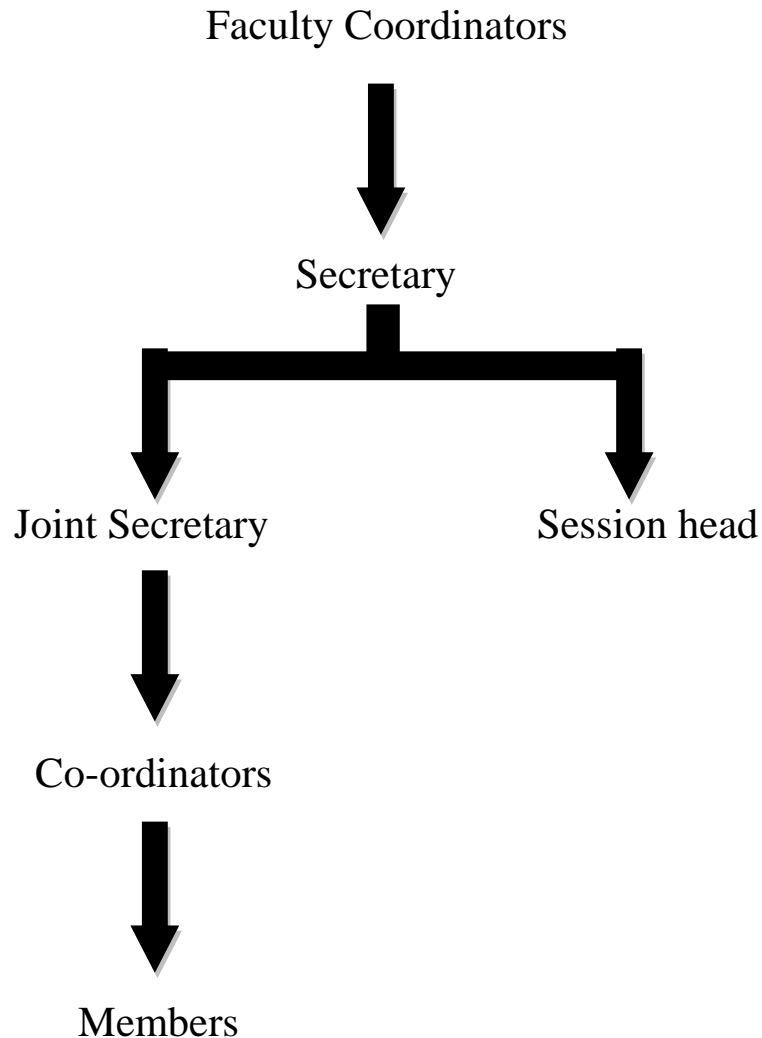
The activities of the club are organized by the elected student representatives each year.
